Looking for the ultimate ELDEN RING tabletop experience? This guide tells you how to combine the three core sets.

The official tabletop adaptation of the smash-hit ELDEN RING video game includes three main sets: Realm of the Grafted King, Weeping Peninsula, and Stormveil Castle. Each set can be played (and replayed) as a co-operative 1-4 player board game. Starting at any core set, you'll become brave Tarnished on a journey to gain the title of Elden Lord. The three core sets all work standalone, including self-contained campaigns ranging from 20-50 hours. Using this guide, you can combine the sets for even grander campaigns.



Weeping Peninsula

The Weeping Peninsula, is named for its unceasing rainfall, redolent of lament and home to all manner of misbegotten creatures... the perfect starting place for brave Tarnished.

Step into a melancholy land filled with secrets, powerful artifacts, and grave danger. Choose your Tarnished, and fight your way across this cursed headland. Customise your Tarnished and test your mettle in a climactic clash against the nightmarish Leonine Misbegotten.



Realm of the Grafted King

Now's the time to steel yourself and level up your Tarnished as you take on the Realm of the Grafted King. This set will see you fighting your way through the decaying landscape of Limgrave in an immersive 50+ hour campaign.

Danger lurks behind every corner—overcome deadly challenges on your path to becoming Elden Lord.



Stormveil Castle

You've come this far, but will you brave Stormveil Castle? As you travel north of Limgrave, this immense structure dominates the skyline. This is the seat of Godrick the Grafted, distant descendent of Godfrey, the first Elden Lord.

Slay the horrific abominations he has let loose in the castle halls, before taking on the Grafted King himself...



Flying Dragon Agheel

A terrifying sight to behold, Flying Dragon Agheel has already laid waste to regions of Limgrave by the time your Tarnished return to the Lands Between; and no location has suffered more than the aptly-named Dragon Burnt Ruins.



Erdtree Avatar

Will you best the Erdtree Avatar and Guardian warriors, devoted protectors of the Erdtree and its offspring? Their large swordspears and tendency to group up can make them tricky to defeat!
